DAYCARE

Carolina Canine College offers a unique doggy Daycare experience, as it is limited to ten dogs a day & supervised by a legitimate dog trainer. You may choose a half-day option of any 4.5 hours or full-day. All Daycare dogs are expected to have basic manners; they are trained to "wait" at the gate, "come" to a whistle, & "sit" politely for treats. Regular Daycare hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 am - 5:30 pm; however, special circumstances are considered. Weekend Daycare available upon request & availability.

TRAINING

Carolina Canine College offers high quality training with exclusive benefits not often provided by dog trainers. Sessions are video recorded & uploaded for your review along with a progress report. Private lessons offered as well as two types of group classes: Drop-Ins & multi-week Courses. Pre-registration is required as most classes require at least three dog & handler teams to move forward. Light or intensive Day Training is offered for pups who need a solid foundation from an experienced trainer.

BOARDING

For select clients, Carolina Canine College offers Boarding at the trainer's home. Only one family at a time, no more than two dogs. Regular Boarding or Board & Train options.

RENT-A-RING

Group Classes

Our 2025 COURSE offerings are as follows:

Beginner Obedience Five-week course, Saturdays @ 11:00 am, limited to six dog/handler teams. This class introduces basic obedience skills such as heel, sit, down, focus, stay, come, leave it, & more! Week I: Orientation, handlers only (no dogs); Weeks 2-4: Group classes; Week 5: Private, one-on-one lesson. \$180

Beginner Rally Four-week course, limited to six dog/handler teams. Got signs? This class introduces you to the concept of rally and how to navigate simple signs while reinforcing basic obedience skills such as heel, sit, down, stay, & more. The instructor is a rally judge for ASCA & has handled many dogs to AKC & ASCA rally titles. \$140

CGC (Canine Good Citizen) This five-week course can open many doors for you & your dog! The American Kennel Club offers the Canine Good Citizen test, which includes ten socially relevant skills, Saturdays @ 12:30 pm. Price include AKC's fees & the test itself. \$225 (\$180 if your dog is already registered with AKC)

NOVICE Tricks Four-week course on Saturdays @ 3:30 pm. The American Kennel Club offers a TKN title if you & your dog can perform ten simple tricks! Possible tricks include: speak, fetch, high five, jump, kennel up, shake, spin, touch, tunnel, & more. We will work on tricks during the classes & test when ready; price includes the AKC test fee. \$215 (\$170 if your dog is already registered with AKC)

NOVICE Obedience This four-week course on Thursday evenings @ 6:30 pm is for those who would like to hone obedience skills. Skills covered include proper heel position, straight sits & fronts, stand, down, recall, & more. The instructor is an obedience judge for ASCA & has handled many dogs to AKC & ASCA obedience titles. \$140

Agility 101 Four-week course, Sundays @ 2:30 pm, limited to six dog/handler teams. This class introduces basic agility obstacles & handling skills. \$140

Agility 202 Four-week course, Sundays @ I pm, limited to six dog/handler teams. This class continues to build upon basic agility handling skills& introduces new obstacles; must have completed Agility 101 to register for this class. \$140

All **Drop-In classes** are \$25 each with packages available.* You MUST pre-register or text Janet of your interest in order to ensure the class's viability on any given day.

Our 2025 **DROP-IN** offerings are as follows:

Obedience Mondays @ 10:30 am. Any level from Beginner Novice through Utility welcome. The instructor is an obedience judge for ASCA & has handled many dogs to AKC & ASCA obedience titles. Skills dependent upon level.

Virtual Runs Mondays @ 6:00 pm. The AKC (American Kennel Club) offers a variety of titles which can be achieved through recording the run & submitting to AKC virtually. The instructor will work with you to practice & record your best run to submit to AKC for any applicable title. This class can go forward with just one team; \$40/class (*not eligible for Drop-In package pricing). No more than three dog & handler teams per session.

Conformation Handling This class is for those who show in conformation with their dogs. Skills covered are hand stacking, free stacking, baiting, & gaiting. The instructor is a conformation judge for the Australian Shepherd Club of America & has handled many dogs to conformation championships. Please be knowledgeable of your dog's breed standard & breed specific ring procedures.

NOVice/Intermediate Rally Saturdays @ 9:30 am; all exercises performed onleash. Either AKC or ASCA (Australian Shepherd Club of America) signs will be used in order to expose you & your dog to a variety of skills. The instructor is a rally judge for ASCA & has handled many dogs to AKC & ASCA rally titles.

Advanced Rally Sundays @ 10:00 am. Advanced Rally is off-leash with more complicated signs to navigate. Either AKC or ASCA (Australian Shepherd Club of America) signs will be used in order to expose you to a variety of skills. The instructor is a rally judge for ASCA & has handled many dogs to AKC & ASCA rally titles.

EXCEllent/Masters Rally Sundays @ 11:15 am. Excellent & Masters Rally are both performed off-leash with jumps & more complicated signs to navigate. Either AKC or ASCA (Australian Shepherd Club of America) signs will be used in order to expose you & your dog to a variety of skills. The instructor is a rally judge for ASCA & has handled many dogs to AKC & ASCA rally titles.

GAROLINA GANINE GOLLEGE

COMMANDS

These are the terms we use while training at Carolina Canine College. You certainly do not have to use these terms, but whatever word(s) you choose, you must be consistent. In other words, please say "Down" only when you want the dog to lie down and "Off" (or some other word) for when a dog needs to get off the couch. The other big pair is "Wait" versus "Stay". For my dogs, "Wait" means to hang out in the general area, but no big deal if they move. If I say "Stay" to my dog, I expect her to stay where I left her, without moving position, until I come back to release her.

Please note that these terms are COMMANDS, not questions or suggestions. You should always deliver commands with an assertive voice; not aggressive, but also not passive. Your dog needs to know that it's a command, so get his attention first.

Back – back up (in heel position)

Come - come sit front while looking at me

Come Around – turn right

Down - lie down

Drop It! - drop whatever's in your mouth, dog!

Easy - don't bite the hand that feeds you, dog!

Fetch - go pick it up, dog!

Front – dog sits facing handler

Get Back / Get In - turn left

Get Dressed! – put collar and/or leash on

Give - release what's in your mouth, dog!

Go Crate – kennel up

GOOD - dog is in the right place or doing the right thing

Go On! - forward focus

Go Potty – go potty



Heel – dog's right shoulder lined up with handler's left ankle Here – come here to this general area Hit It! - two (rear) paws on, two (front) paws on the ground Hup - jump up Hurry - speed up Jackpot! - BIG reward; CRAZY high-pitched praise, pets, & treats! Jump - jump over Leave It! - do **NOT** touch under ANY circumstances Let's Go! - heel Look/Watch Me - make and maintain eye contact Off – get off (my leg, the couch, counter, etc.) NOW! Okay – release word Over - jump over Quiet – for the love of Pete, PLEASE stop barking! Shake – paw offered to handler Side – dog on the handler's right side Sit – sit Speak – bark Stand - stand Stay – dog does NOT move from the place left or change position Target – go touch something out in the distance Teeter – teeter totter Through – through tunnel or tire Touch – touch my hand, or this thing, or that thing Tunnel – go through the tunnel Walk It! - any agility contact obstacle Wait – hang out here, but it's okay if you move a bit Weave! - weave poles

Yes! – dog is in the right place or doing the right thing

<u>WHAT TO BRING</u>: Please arrive with your dog in an appropriate collar with a lightweight, six-foot leash. Have non-crunchy training treats with you that are different from treats given at home. Some dogs are sensitive to water changes; bring bottled water or water from home if necessary.

<u>GENERAL</u>: All visitors to **Carolina Canine College** must sign the waiver upon entering the facility for the first time & provide each dog's current vaccination records. Owners are expected to clean up after their dogs; bags provided & waste should be placed in the outdoor trashcan. NO RETRACTABLE LEASHES permitted on property.

<u>PARTICIPATION</u>: Enrollment in our classes & seminars is limited; your participation is important to us. Once you have registered, we are counting on you to attend. If **Carolina Canine College** cancels your class, you will receive a full refund or the ability to use the fee towards a new class.

<u>WITHDRAW</u>: A student wishing to withdraw from a class that has not been cancelled by **Carolina Canine College** must give at least one week notice before the scheduled start of the class for a full refund, less \$20 administrative fee. In the case of verified medical/hardships, a credit may be given.

<u>REFUNDS</u>: Carolina Canine College will not refund class fees if the student/dog is asked to withdraw from the class due to behavior of the dog.

<u>MAKE-UP LESSONS</u>: If a student misses a class and wishes to attend a make-up, one will be offered at the instructor's discretion.

<u>WEATHER</u>: If unable to hold a class due to weather (or other unforeseen circumstances), a make-up class will be scheduled. Every effort will be made to hold the make-up class on the same day and time as the original class; however, if weather or other circumstances preclude the instructor from holding class on that day and time, the class will be scheduled for another day and time.

Too many dogs are dropped off at shelters because they didn't get proper training and owners can no longer deal with destructive & uncontrollable behaviors. That being said, it's also never too late for an old dog to learn new tricks!


This program offers:


- <u>Fast Results</u>: Your dog learns directly from a professional and receives several hours of hands-on training per day. On average, your dog will receive 30+ private contact training sessions during one week of Bootcamp.
- <u>Repetitive</u>, <u>Reinforced Learning</u>: Your dog spends the entire day in a controlled and structured environment where every decision is guided and reinforced. Many dogs find this situation very therapeutic.
- Reduced Stress: Your dog is allowed to work through the challenging early stages of training that many owners may not have the time or knowledge to apply consistently. Your dog will learn desired behaviors through consistent, repetitive reinforcement, thereby extinguishing problematic behaviors without conflict, combat, or stress.
- Enhanced Customization: The amount of time the trainer spends with your dog during Bootcamp allows a much deeper understanding of your dog's unique learning preferences. Specific strategies & exercises are designed for each individual dog. This is especially valuable with difficult behavioral cases.

<u>Required Equipment</u>: An appropriate training collar (no harnesses). If your dog is on a special diet, please provide the trainer with compatible treats.

* Please do not feed your pup in the mornings of Camp; if you'd like, you can bring your dog's breakfast for the instructor to use as treats for training.







There are three categories to choose from for booking:

- 3. Reservations (Daycare).


1. Click on your dog's picture and the "START BOOKING" button will turn from gray to **BLUE**. **Home**

4. Choose day(s) & enter your drop-off & pick-up times; then the "SERVICES" button will turn **BLUE**.




5. Once you have added all your days, click the blue "ADD DATES" button.



6. Even though a green screen pops up that says, "Success! Your dates have been requested!", you're not quite finished yet. Click **SERVICES**.


